Two Student Research Awards

Nominations are being sought for two student research awards, the Adams Outstanding Master's Thesis/Project Award, and the Adams Outstanding Doctoral Thesis Award. Both awards are made available through the A. Elwood & Juneth S. Adams Scholarship/Fellowship Fund. Awards will not be made unless there is a truly outstanding candidate.

Nominations will be made by advisors for candidates who add significantly to the body of knowledge and professional practice. Only those candidates whose dissertation or thesis has been officially completed between March 1, 2011 and March 1, 2012 will be considered for the Honor's Day Awards. Nominations and a copy of the submission will be reviewed by a faculty committee selected by the Dean's office.
