

ADAMS STUDENT FELLOWSHIP AWARD

Applications are now being sought for one doctoral student fellowship to provide a student support for full-time study. The fellowship consists of a \$13,000 scholarship, 18 credits of tuition waiver, \$2,000 for professional development expenses, and office space. The fellowship will be a one year award as long as the student remains in good standing. Should the Fellow wish to reapply, he/she can reapply for a second year but he/she will be considered as all others in the application pool.

The Adams Fellowship will be awarded to an applicant who shows great promise as a member of the future professoriate. Preference will be given to areas of need for the professoriate.

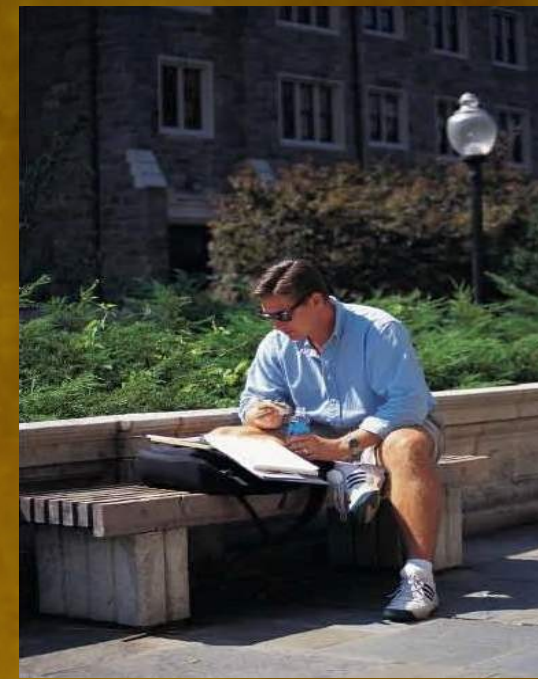
