As a result of a trust left in memory of Indiana State University's seventh President, Dr. Raleigh Holmstedt, a grant will be awarded to one member of the Bayh College of Education Faculty who has demonstrated a long and distinguished career of teaching, scholarship, and service. The award is intended to be a culminating event recognizing seven years or more of exemplary and extraordinary teaching, service, and scholarship.

The recipient must be a Bayh College of Education faculty member who has attained the rank of associate or professor with a minimum of seven-years service to Indiana State University. The faculty member must devote all or a substantial portion, at least a .75 load, of his/her professional work to teaching graduate and undergraduate courses, research, and service. The award can be granted to any individual only one time.

Selection will be made from among applicants by a committee consisting of one member from each department in the Bayh College of Education nominated by the Executive Committee of the Bayh College of Education Congress and the Dean of the Bayh College of Education. The Selection Committee will be approved by the Bayh College of Education Congress. In cases of a tie vote among the selection committee, the Dean of the Bayh College of Education will provide the tie breaking vote.

**Application Process:** Applications are due in the Dean's Office by 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, February 15, 2012 for the fiscal year 2012-2013 appointment. The application process and guidelines are available at <http://coe.indstate.edu/congress>.

**Award:** The award is not a cash award. Rather, the award is to be used for the hiring of adjunct faculty to provide reassigned time to complete proposal project, scholarly travel, research materials, or equipment, and/or funding of fellowships or assistantships for graduate students to assist the recipient in research and instructional activities. The recipient of the award will receive a tangible symbol of the award and bear the title of Holmstedt Distinguished Professor for the entire fiscal year of the award.
