Nominations are now being sought for the **2012 Reitzel Faculty Research Award**. This award is being offered and is funded through the Helen Reitzel Trust. The Faculty member's research must be rigorous, utilize acceptable research methodologies, and contribute to the knowledge base in its field. Work involving essay or opinion only, are not eligible for consideration. Research must be completed, have been presented or published in 2011, and appear in the faculty member's annual report for 2011. The faculty member will also be invited to present the research to faculty and students. A committee appointed by the Dean will review the applications and make a recommendation for the award to the Dean.

All tenured and tenure-track faculty are eligible for this award. Self-nomination is acceptable and encouraged.
