TITLE: Graduate Assistant, Student Judicial Programs

OVERVIEW: The Graduate Assistant, under the leadership and supervision of the Director of Student Judicial Programs, assists with the responsibilities associated with the administration and enforcement of the Code of Student Conduct. He or she will be involved with the implementation and maintenance of those programs and services that address the behavioral expectations of students enrolled at Indiana State University.

PRIMARY DUTIES INCLUDE:

Serves as a hearing officer

Consults with appropriate offices in a collaborative and liaison relationship

Assists with assignments and projects that further the goals of Student Judicial Programs

Other duties as assigned

Waiver of tuition (in-state or out-of-state) is included in the compensation package. Student fees remain the responsibility of the student. A stipend of \$7,500 is paid to each graduate assistant during the ten-month employment period. Opportunities for summer employment may also be available.
