

Multimedia Classrooms

The College of Education has several multimedia classrooms (Rooms 115, 116, 117, 118, 225, 226, 301, 305, 322, 614, 1014, 1214, 1514, 11th Floor Conference Rooms 1 and 2). Each of these classrooms is equipped with a computer with Internet access and PowerPoint software, as well as connections for VCR, DVD, and Video Imager operations. There is a mounted projector for display, and speakers for sound. Each classroom also has access to cable television. The IITS/IRC also has several mobile multimedia carts that can travel to any classroom and projectors available for checkout.



COE Computer Labs

The COE departmental computer labs are the Statistics Lab in Room 1320 (EDPS department), School Counseling Lab in Room 1510, and Communication Disorders Lab in Room 415. Contact the department for more information.



Coordinated Service IT Computer Lab

Instructional and Information Technology Services

The purpose of Instructional and Information Technology Services (IITS) is to facilitate the utilization of instructional and informational technologies by the faculty, staff, and students in the College of Education. This mission includes:

- Supporting the technology needs of faculty and students as they relate to learning, instruction and research, as well as the initiatives designed to help faculty infuse relevant information technology into the professional education programs
- Offering instructional delivery systems and current digital technology for educational productions to College of Education faculty, staff, and students
- Coordinating all facets of technology in the College of Education, including the procurement, installation, utilization, support and management of the information technology resources and facilities
- Providing technical support to the College of Education - Information Technology Advisory Committee.

Multimedia Development Lab

The Multimedia Lab is dedicated to providing multimedia and electronic portfolio services to all students and faculty in the College of Education. The lab also has direct involvement with the graduate students in the media technology program. This facility offers productivity tools, digital imaging and editing, multimedia programming, presentation design, and video editing through such notable software as Adobe Photoshop, Premiere, Macromedia Dreamweaver, Director, and Microsoft Office 2003 & 2007. Each PC has a scanner attached as well. The lab is located in Room 106 in the College of Education. There is also dedicated audio and video production labs in Room 104.



Equipment Checkout

To assist College of Education faculty and staff in the utilization and integration of technology, IITS has a variety of computer, audio, and video equipment available for checkout. This equipment includes:

- Notebook/tablet computers
- digital cameras
- digital video cameras
- tripods
- portable projectors
- media card readers

This equipment is also available for check out to graduate students. Equipment may be checked out in Room 105 in the College of Education.



Classroom Services

Educators have found that using technology in class makes their classes more engaging and effective. The IITS makes available equipment such as wireless laptop carts, multimedia carts, SMART Boards™, and TV/VCR/DVD carts. Instructional Resource Center

The IRC (Room 105) offers binding, lamination, Ellison machines and media equipment available for faculty, staff and student use. Faculty may place materials on reserve checkout for use by their students.
